Qatar Urges Cooperation between All States to Advance Goals of 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development



Last October 4th 2017, the State of Qatar stated that the United Nations 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development aims at peoples all over the world. The Qatari government said it was a comprehensive framework for efforts to promote world peace, eradicate poverty in all its forms and dimensions, and ensure that no one is left behind.

Qatar Delivers Medical Aid to Somalia

A military plane, affiliated to the Emiri Air Force, was dispatched to Mogadishu with medical aid shortly after the African nation suffered the worst terrorist attack in its history.

The truck bomb explosion slightly wounded HE the Charge d' Affaires and severely damaged the building of the Qatari embassy.

The medical assistance included a team of doctors and nurses of the Qatar International Search and Rescue Group, in addition to two tons of medicines and medical supplies, to treat

people injured in the bombing that hit the centre of the capital on October 14th. After arrival in Mogadishu, the plane transported 27 injured Somalis along with their 27 companions to the Sudanese capital Khartoum for treatment. More than 300 people were killed in the terrorist attack, among them, senior civil servants, five paramedic volunteers and a journalist, but most were ordinary people.

Cuban Minister of Foreign Affairs Meets H.E. Ambassador of Qatar

On October 20th, the Cuban Foreign Affairs Minister, Bruno Rodriguez, met with H.E. Rashid Mairza Al-Mulla.

They talked on the bilateral relations, which are based on mutual respect and consensus in foreign policy, and about the current Gulf crisis, which started in May 2017.

The Cuban Minister referred to his recent visit to Doha, which was positive and productive. He also thanked H.H The Emir father for his participation in the funeral of his friend, the late Fidel Castro, and the speech given on this occasion.

Other topics of interest were the promotion of international peace and security as well as the defense of the right to self-determination. The use of dialogue as a means to negotiate and solve conflicts was emphasised.

By the end of the meeting, the Cuban Foreign Minister welcomed the visit of the Qatari Minister of Foreign Affairs or the Minister of State for Foreign Affairs to the Republic of Cuba.

Qatar National Bank (QNB) Will Open an Office in Havana

The Gulf's largest listed lender, Qatar National Bank (QNB), will open a representative office in Havana, becoming the first bank from the rich energy-exporting countries of the Gulf to do so. Government-controlled QNB has obtained regulatory approvals needed to open the office, in line with its strategy of expanding in selected countries.

Foreign banks have been reluctant to enter Cuba, to a large extent, because of the risk of being found in violation of U.S. economic sanctions; however, in March 2016, as part of a U.S. opening to Cuba, new business possibilities have been opened up.

QNB has a presence in over 30 countries across Europe, the Middle East, Africa and Asia.

Cuban Doctors in Qatar: An Oasis in the Desert

A Cuban hospital started its operations in Qatar after it was formally opened by the Father Emir Shaikh Hamad Bin Khalifa Al Thani and the Cuban Health Minister, Roberto Morales.

According to Qatari media, the Cuban Hospital is a modern therapeutic facility designed to meet the needs of the growing population of the western region of Qatar.

The staff is composed of more than 450 medical professionals provided by the Caribbean island, including doctors, nurses and specialists in the fields of rehabilitation, dentistry, pathology, bio-

medicine and radiology. The CEO, Mr. Lowen, has said they are planning to further expand the range of orthopedic, plastic surgery, and specialist dental services in 2018.

The hospital, located in Dukhan and under the umbrella of the Hamad Medical Corporation, is the outcome of joint efforts to develop the different fields of co-operation since the establishment of diplomatic relations between the two countries. It also shows the exchange of views between the governments of Qatar and Cuba.

Qatari Diar & Cuba: Building a Sustainable Future

Qatari Diar Real Estate Investment Co. and the Republic of Cuba signed a Memorandum of Agreement to develop luxury hotels in the Caribbean island. Qatari Diar – established in December 2004 to support Qatar's growing economy – creates distinguished property developments, enhanced with local, cultural and lifestyle experiences to attract tourism and new residents, generating sustainable and tangible socio-economic benefits.
